New cases estimated by applying age-, sex-, and race/ethnic-specific incidence rates for Texas 2005-2009, to the projected Texas 2013 population. Melanoma, breast and prostate cancer expected cases were estimated by applying California 2005-2009 age-, sex-, and race/ethnic-specific incidence rates to the projected Texas 2013 population. California rates were used for these sites due to additional case-ascertainment methods used in California, and similar race and ethnic populations.

Expected deaths estimated by applying age-, sex-, and race/ethnic-specific mortality rates for Texas, 2008-2009, to the projected Texas 2013 population.

Texas population projections for 2013 were provided by the Center for Health Statistics, Texas Department of State Health Services on January 31, 2013 (statewide), February 4, 2013 (Health Service Regions), February 11, 2013 (Counties).
