


2014 Texas Selected Cancer Facts




Harris County

In 2014, it is estimated that there will be 16,534 new cancer cases and 6,373 cancer deaths in Harris County.

Leukemia (ICCC* Group I)	703	28.5%
Brain/Central Nervous System (III)	525	21.3%
Lymphoma (II)	299	12.1%
All Other Groups	938	38.1%
