SUBJECT: Nutramigen AA Name Change

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Mead Johnson has informed the state agency that it has changed the name of **Nutramigen AA powder** (formula code 460) to **Puramino**. Prescriptions with either name may be accepted and approved for the same medical reasons. This formula is a drop-ship or pharmacy item not typically available at standard grocery stores.

- The formula code, can size, reconstituted ounces and ingredients remain the same.
- Participants can buy either formula name with the same 460 code on their cards beginning January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
- Shopping lists and TWIN formula pick lists will continue to read Nutramigen AA until after the next clinic formula table update scheduled for March 2013.
- Please reassure participants that the two names represent the same formula.
