**SUBJECT:** Breast Pump Training IDL Revisions December 18, 2013

This memo is to announce changes to the Breast Pump Trainings that are required by Policy BF: 04.0. Due to the recent discontinuation of IDL trainings, the Texas WIC breast pump trainings have been converted to CenturyLink and expanded into two (2) trainings.

- ◆ **Texas WIC Breast Pump Program – Part 1:** This training will enhance skills needed for using the inventory logs during breast pump issuance, retrieval, and reconciliation.
- ◆ **Texas WIC Breast Pump Program – Part 2:** This training will provide staff with an understanding of how to use, issue, and troubleshoot breast pumps.

As of January 1, 2014, all recorded Breast Pump IDL trainings are obsolete and should be discarded. New staff members need to attend the Texas WIC Breast Pump Program trainings, Part 1 and 2, offered via CenturyLink, in order to satisfy the training requirements in Policy BF: 04.0.
